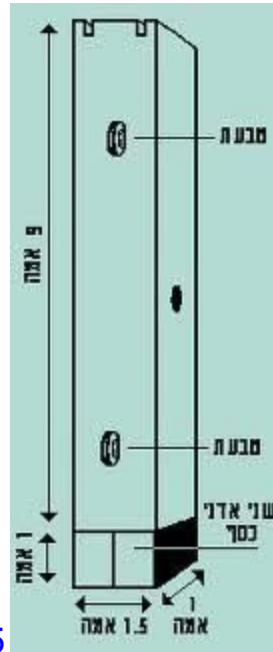

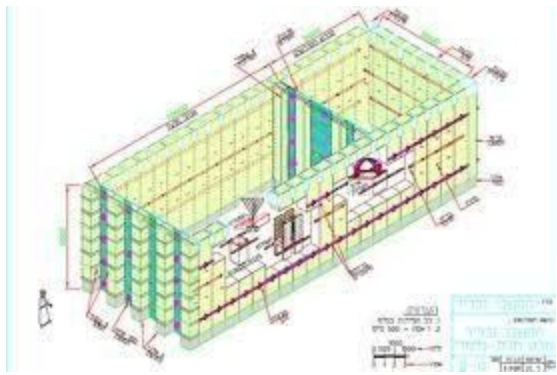

The vestments of the regular Kohen:

1. K'tonet-tunic
2. Michnasayim-trousers
3. Avnet- belt
4. Mitznefet-miter

The vestments of the Kohen Gadol include the above plus the following:

1. Me'eel – A "tchelet" died poncho, trimmed with gold bells and pom-poms
2. Efod- A type of apron worn backwards
3. Choshen- a breastplate containing 12 precious stones representing each tribe
4. Tzitz- A golden diadem containing th
